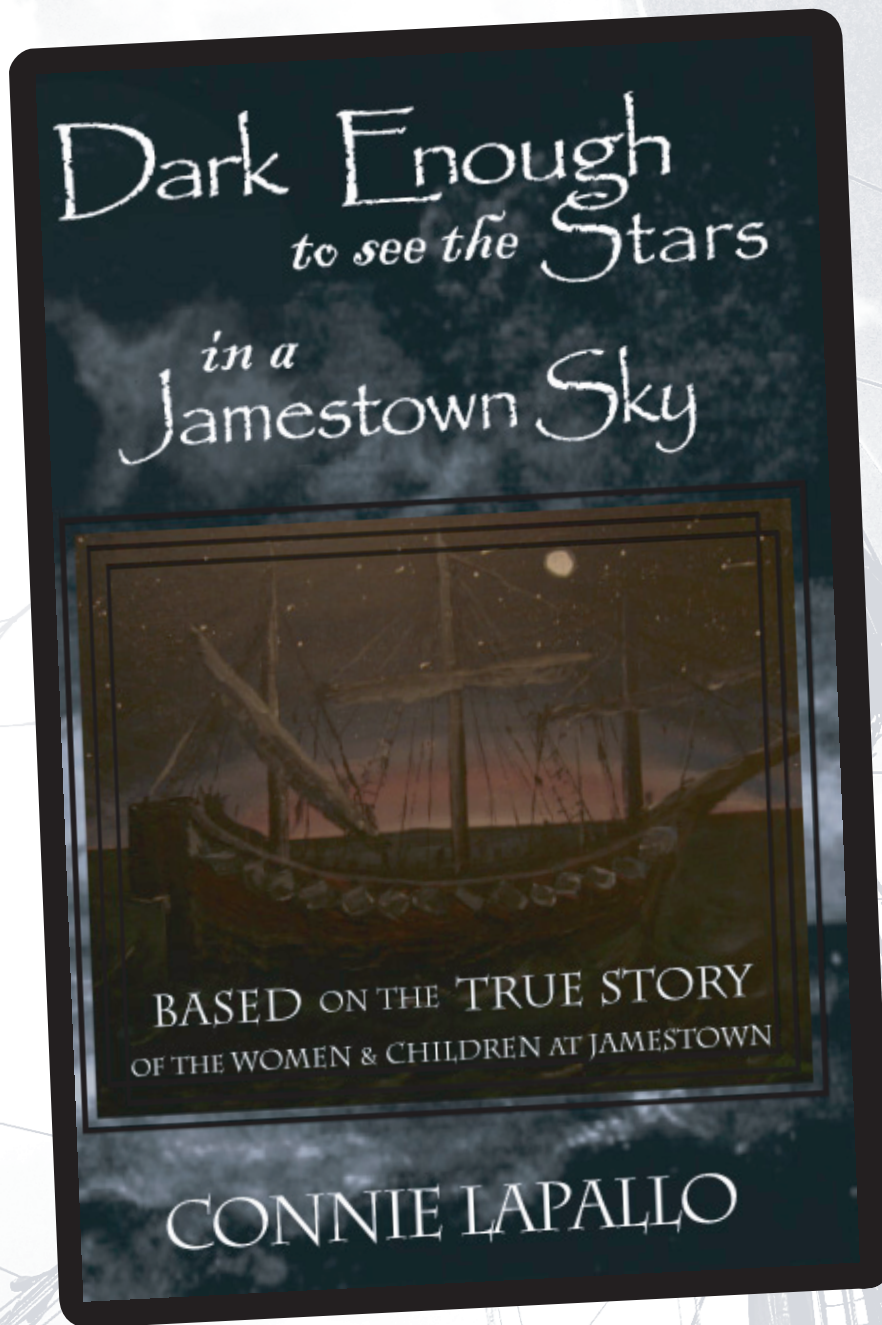


# author connie lapallo
